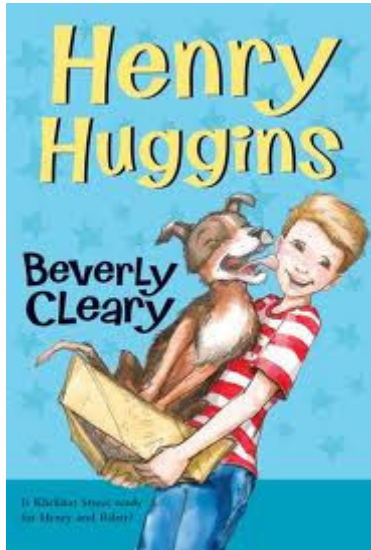

All children must be accompanied by an adult.

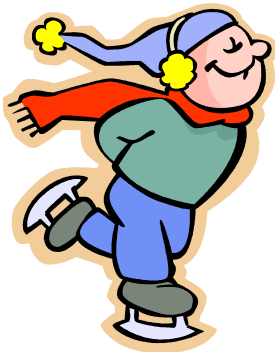

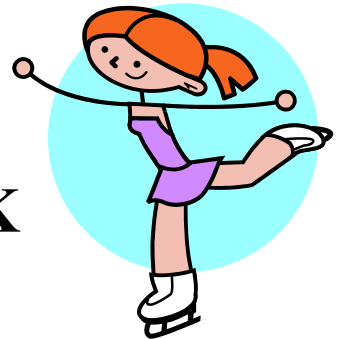
